SOLAR POWER PRESENTATION

Progressive Business Solutions presented their proposal to install solar panels at the Middle School & High School. The power purchase agreement would be a 25 year fixed rate of \$0.0560/kwh. Dan Ford (maintenance) said that he was worried about roof leaks but after research he is no longer concerned and believes that solar panels may extend the life of the roof. Mr. Miller suggested that we should wait to make a decision until we talk to HBR and Marmion as they are having theirs installed this fall.

UPDATE ON MIDDLE SCHOOL ROOF

Dan Ford provided an update on the Middle School roof project. The crane is gone and they are now working with ladders. Sheet metal will be replaced next week, which is the final step. The Middle School PE classes will need to enter/exit from different doors next week.

STUDENT SAFETY

Mr. Heilemier presented the District's student safety plans. He is also looking into an ID Scanning system for all building visitors.

HIGH SCHOOL FALL SPORTS UPDATE

Dr. Darnell presented the current numbers for fall sports. He also stated that all the Senior football players, but one, have found other activities to participate in.

FREE/REDUCED AND CEP PROGRAM

Mr. Sodaro explained that the new State CEP program does not apply to our entire district. Only three of our schools qualify. It is not a true free program as our district would have to pay the difference. Mr Sodaro is unable to give an exact number since it is based on who actually takes lunch or breakfast. The board of education did not authorize Mr. Sodaro to formally apply for CEP.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

A. Teaching and Learning

Assistant Superintendent Ryan Janisch presented the current NSES curriculum. He explained that we have opted out for this school year 2022-2023. Mr. Sodaro pointed out that it is a non-adoption not an opt out according to the State of Illinois.

Mr. Miller recommended that they take a straw poll to opt out of this program.

B. Teacher SIP Welcome Day

C. Enrollment Update

Superintendent Sodaro updated the board on current enrollment and stated that more families are still registering. We added another Kindergarten class and another 6th grade class. He also stated that we have a shortage of bus drivers, making things difficult for our transportation department. There is an overflow of students who are attending schools not in their residential area.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Members of the community provided public comment on the NSES curriculum, transportation for the overflow students, new athletic trainer, K-12 curriculum, and K-12 library books.
